2. What brought you out of that season? Who was with you during this time? What change did this dark season bring about in your life?

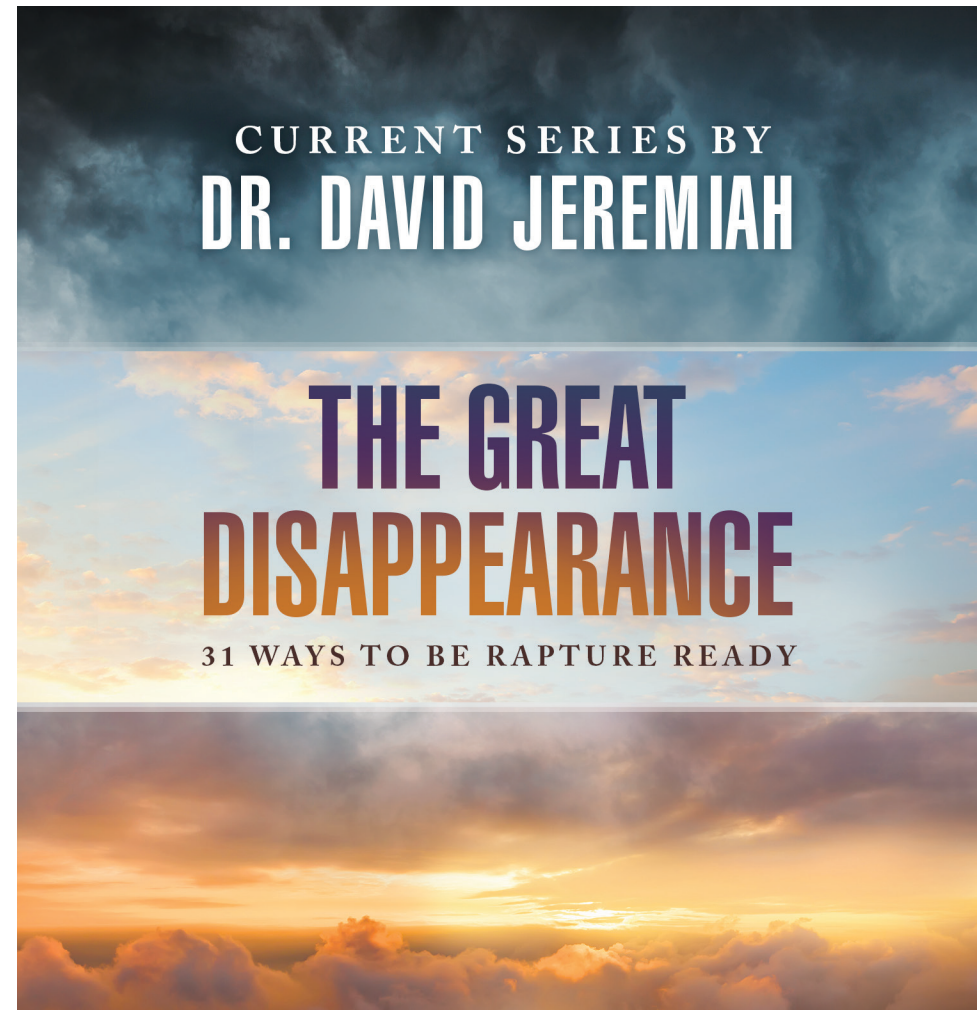
Digging Deeper

4. Read Hebrews 4:15 and Hebrews 12:2. In this world where “you will have tribulation” (John 16:33), how does it feel to know that Jesus sympathizes with our weaknesses? Further, what does it say about His willingness to endure the cross on your behalf?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 15:42-44. What are the four contrasts between our present body and our future body? Describe how it will feel to have a brand new body.
